JUDGMENT

HIS HONOUR: This is an application for a winding up of Tropical Seafood Operations Pty Ltd on the grounds of its insolvency.

The insolvency is proven and presumption arises by reason of the company's failure to respond to a statutory demand served upon it on the 23rd of March 2004. That demand made a claim for the repayment of a loan of \$67,000 lent to the company by one of its directors, Mr William Eric Wilson.

The company has failed to respond to that demand and so a presumption of insolvency arises. If further evidence were required there was a previous statutory demand dated and served on the 23rd of October 2003 which was not complied with.

The Registrar has issued his certificate on 18th of May 2004 certifying that the procedural requirements have been fulfilled. In those circumstances I make orders in terms of the draft initialled by me and placed with the papers.
